- Dual controls
- Engines torn down, inspected, some parts replaced, reprocessed master rod bearings
- Fire bottles refilled, system tested
- DC-6 wheels and brakes
- Audio panel, intercom, two KY 96A radios, and transponder with encoding altimeter
- Aircraft registered Limited category, meaning seats can be added in the Gunner's compartment
- Spares galore
